



TREASURE HUNT

ENJOY A WALKING TRAIL AROUND THE LOCAL AREA IN AID OF HEMBLINGTON CHURCH REPAIRS

£2 per treasure hunt sheet. PLEASE PUT YOUR ENTRY FEE IN THE CHURCH DONATIONS JAR BY THE DOOR.

You may walk the trail anytime but bear in mind some paths can get muddy after heavy rain. The route starts and ends at Hemblington Church where there are DIY refreshments available (donations welcome). Route takes about 2-3 hours including time to solve clues (approx. 6 km).

You may wish to do the trail on more than one day (parking at North Burlingham church to access some clues if you don't want to walk the route in one day). Some questions are a little cryptic, some may just ask you to count things. There is no need to enter any private property or gardens. Hope you enjoy it.

TURN LEFT OUT OF HEMBLINGTON CHURCHYARD to HEMBLINGTON HALL.

1. How many chimney pots can you spot at Hemblington Hall?
2. How many triangles can you make from the gates when gates closed
3. Is it a fraction or a whole number?

TURN LEFT AT THE T JUNCTION.

4. Ditch the Taurean in a hurry.
5. What year was Hall Farm built?
6. What number do you phone for Jacksons Fine Fencing?

TURN RIGHT ONTO THE FOOTPATH FOLLOWING THE SIGNS FOR BURLINGHAM WOODLAND WALKS. CONTINUE ALONG THE FIELD BOUNDARY

7. He didn't see Eve, but Rod saw Joy in Adam's Wood. Confused?

TURN LEFT AT THE FINGERPOST TO FOLLOW THE PATH.

WHEN THE PATH SPLITS, TAKE THE RIGHT HAND BRANCH.

EXIT THE WOOD AND FOLLOW THE TRACK STRAIGHT AHEAD

**JOIN DELL CORNER LANE AND GO STRAIGHT ON TOWARDS BURLINGHAM GREEN.
(YOU WILL FOLLOW THIS LANE TO THE END, EVENTUALLY REACHING WOODS)**

LEAVE THE WOOD AND ENTER THE CHURCHYARD
